COVID-19 UPDATE – ESSENTIAL CHANGES TO OUR SERVICES

New Zealand is at Covid-19 Alert Level 4. Tui Medical has made the following changes to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our staff and patients.

- All non-essential services have been cancelled.
- All repeat prescriptions must be done online.
- All GP appointments will be via telephone.
- Face to face appointments can only be made if recommended by the doctor you spoke to.
- Nurse Appointments will be available only for flu vaccines, childhood immunisations, and Depo Provera.
- Pop up Flu Vac Clinic OPEN at Tui Medical PARKWOOD for eligible patients.
